TOPIC:

Universal Analysis of Wettability and Adhesion

Wetting and adhesion of materials is governed by their surface free energy (SFE) and its polar and non-polar (disperse) components. To optimize painting, coating, or bonding, the SFE is often increased by pretreatment. Several methods for determining surface free energy have been evaluated in recent years (including dyne pens and contact angle instruments). This talk will focus on the polar and disperse portions of surface free energy that are involved in determining good wettability and good adhesion and helping to make relavant measurements on both the research and quality control sides of the business.

SPEAKER:

Art Kasson – Technical Consultant – Krüss USA

Art Kasson is from Bradfordwoods, PA where he lives with his wife Katie (a Geology professor at Allegheny College) and two children, Maggie (5) and Mac (2).
