Kurt Olson, R&D Fellow for PPG Industries, began his career with PPG in 1981 as a Research Chemist. After promoting through the technical hierarchy, he promoted to Manager, Automotive Resin Research in 1991; Manager, Automotive Spray Technology in 1998; Associate Director, Automotive Coatings in 1999 and Associate Director, OEM Polymer Synthesis in 2010. Kurt was promoted to his current position of R&D Fellow in 2011.

His accomplishments include numerous contributions to the advancement of coatings science. His 54 issued U.S. patents and 12 U.S. patent applications cover a wide area of coating technology including polymer synthesis and coatings formulations for electrodeposition, powder coatings, and waterborne systems. Kurt has participated in the successful commercial development of CeramiClear clearcoat which received a PACE Award in 2003; the development of a light metallic waterborne basecoat for Europe, and a powder clearcoat for automotive applications which received a IR 100 Award in 2002. Additionally, Kurt was elected to the PPG Collegium in 2004, serving as Collegium president in 2011 & 2012, and received the American Chemical Society Pittsburgh Award in 2011.

A native of Pennsylvania, Olson earned a bachelor's degree in chemistry from Ursinus in Collegeville, PA and a doctorate in organic chemistry from the University of Florida in Gainesville, FL.


