# Dr. Christy Martin / INEOS Pigments

Dr. Christy Martin is the Technical Support Manager for INEOS Pigments. She has been with the company for seven years, originally joining as a Principal Scientist working on several global Product R&D initiatives and programs. Prior to joining INEOS Pigments, she was Director – Development for Vorbeck Materials responsible for product development and commercialization of graphene-based products in electronics, energy, and composites technology sectors. In 2012, Dr. Martin was part of a team recognized with a prestigious R&D Magazine R&D 100 Award for "Graphene Nanostructures for Lithium Batteries." Dr. Martin has also worked as a research scientist at Luna Innovations focusing on the development of conductive coatings, direct to metal coatings, low observable materials, and antennas. Christy holds a Ph.D. in inorganic chemistry from the Georgia Institute of Technology and a BS degree in chemistry from James Madison University.

# Relating Properties of Pigments to Coatings Performance

This presentation will discuss how to map coatings product performance to pigment characteristics using structure - property relationships. From the pigment producer view, we think in terms of powder properties such as surface area, particle size, and surface chemistry. But, how does that help the coatings end user formulate for appearance (opacity, gloss) or even manufacturing ease? We will discuss how to bridge the bridge the gap between the two perspectives.
